

## *Saying No To God*

Read Jeremiah 13 v 1-17

Reflect: What were the consequences of someone failing to keep their commitment to you? How did you feel?

- What is surprising about what Jeremiah is asked to do?
- What is the point of this object lesson?
- What is God's complaint? (v9-11) How would that look today?
- The cloth was to cling and give glory, what was it a metaphor of?
- v12-14 were directed to the leaders. What do the the images of drunkenness communicate about the coming judgment?
- v15-16 use the image of darkness and stumbling what do they communicate about the coming judgment?
- What could be the remedy for the coming judgement?
- How is pride seen at the heart of the human condition through the passage?
- v17 What does this verse change about how you see Jeremiah, God?
- How is glory best given to God?

*These questions are to be used as a follow up in small groups, with friends or for personal reflection to the teaching at 8pm on YouTube every second week.*
